



### GARDEN STATE APPALOOSA ASSOCIATION REQUIREMENTS FOR YEAR – END AWARDS

1. Be a member of the Appaloosa Horse Club (ApHC)
2. Be a member in good standing of the Garden State Appaloosa Association before the points will start counting. Membership form and copy of the front and back of the papers must be sent to the membership chairman. LIFETIME MEMBERS MUST SEND IN THEIR COMPLETED MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION AND PAPERS EACH YEAR IN ORDER FOR POINTS TO COUNT.
3. Show at two of the three GSAA shows in the classes for which the award is given (exception weanling halter, and two year old snaffle bit and HUS as these are only held at two GSAA shows.)
4. Provide 3 hours of club service – this can be by working at the horse show, before the horse show getting ready, after the horse show etc.
5. If you do not have time to volunteer at the horse show the buyout program can be utilized. \$100 per member paid before the points will start counting.
6. If work is done at the horse show you must sign up with the person in charge or in the show office when the work is completed. If you have someone else working for you then they must indicate that on the sheet as well. Hours are worked in 30 minute increments and will only be counted as such.
